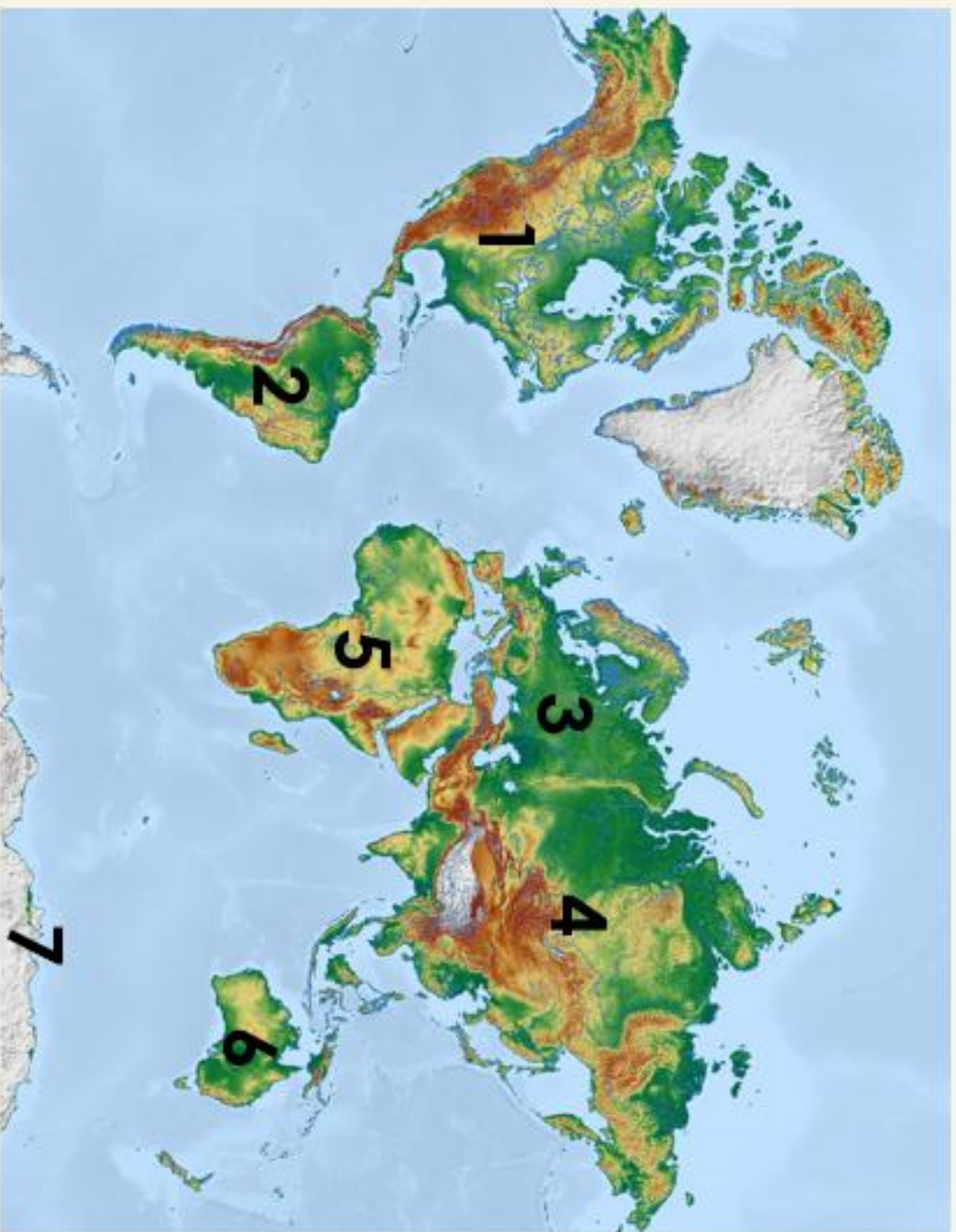

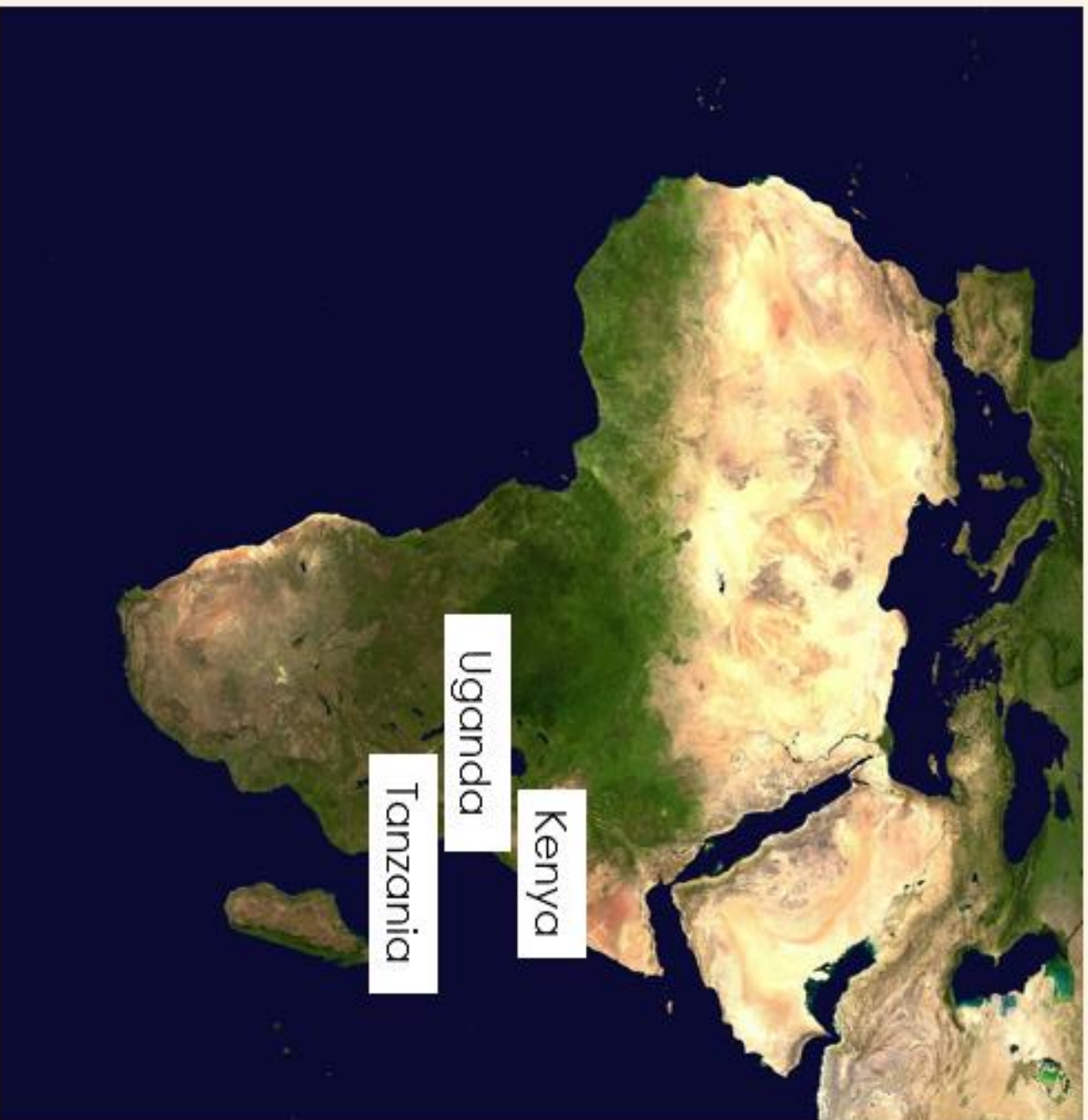

There are fifty-four countries in Africa. Three of those countries are Kenya, Tanzania, and Uganda.



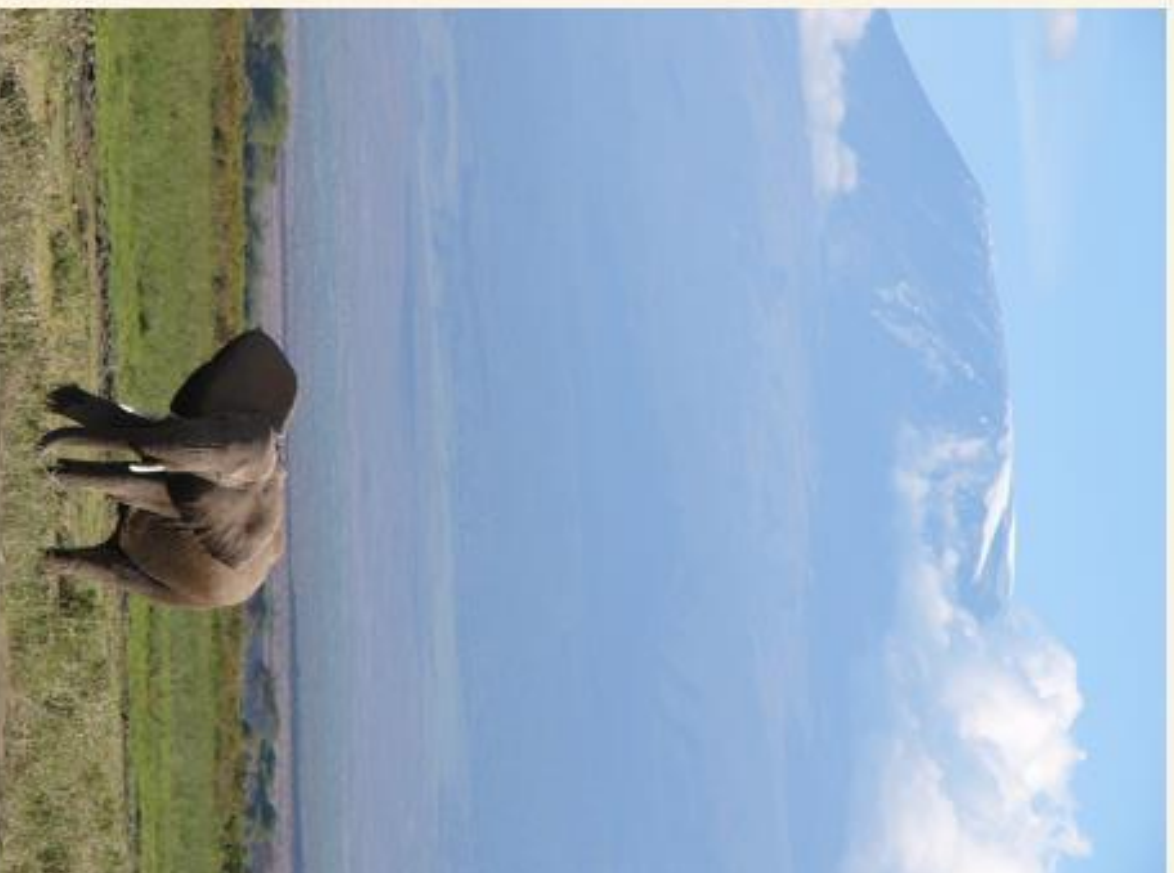
People in Africa live in lots of different places. They live in big cities, on farms out in the country, in small towns, and in neighborhoods.

There are many different habitats in Africa. Unique animals and plants grow and live in each habitat. Let's name the habitats.

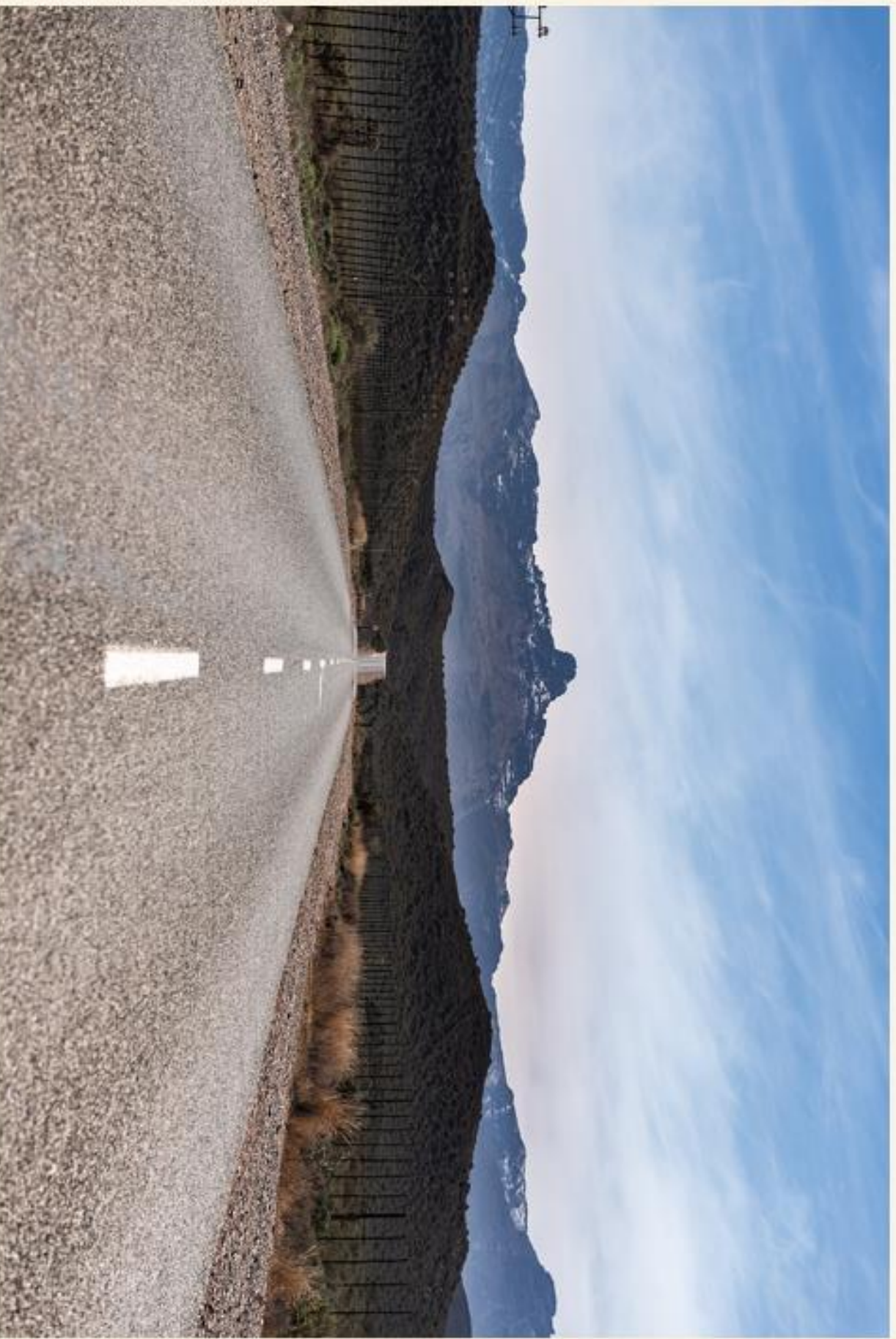


There are flat, grassy places called the savanna.

Giraffes and lions live in the savanna.



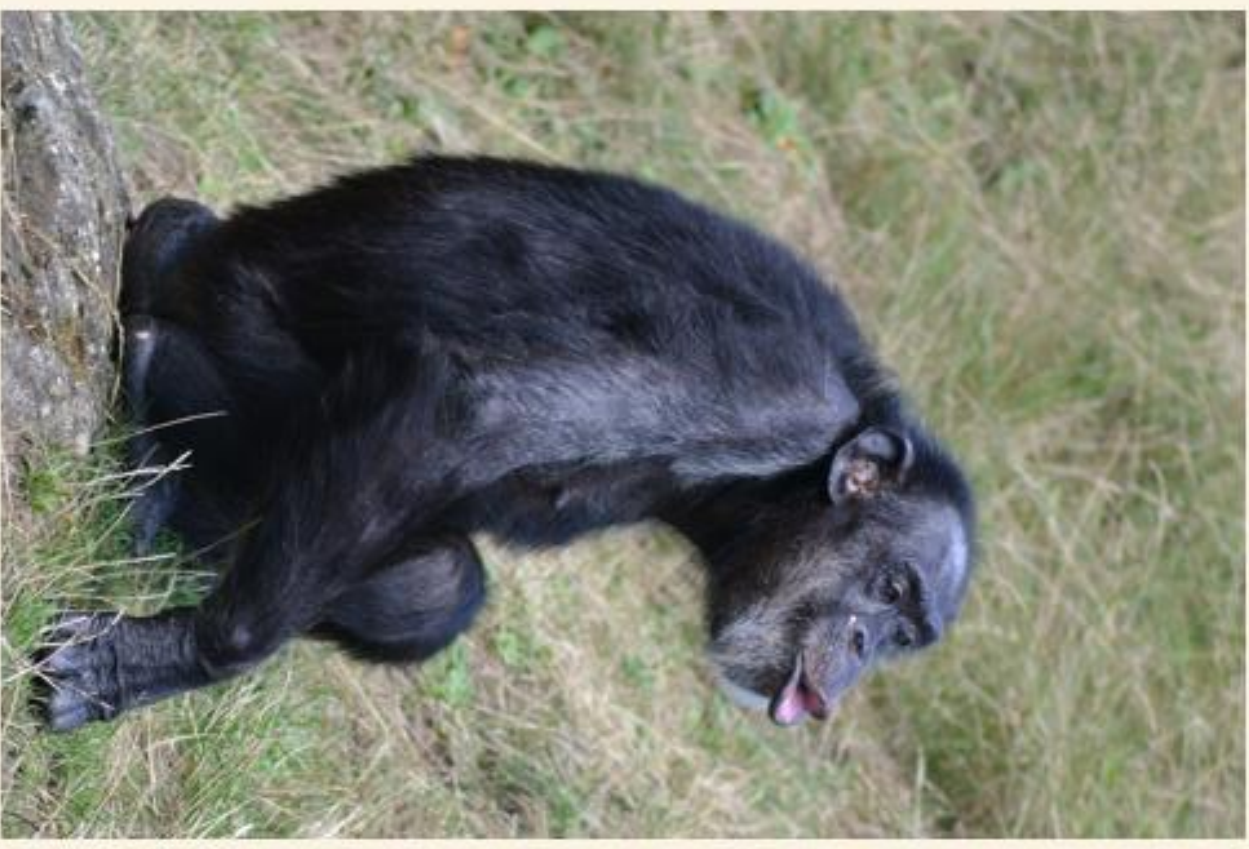
There are tall mountains with high peaks.
What animals live in the mountains?



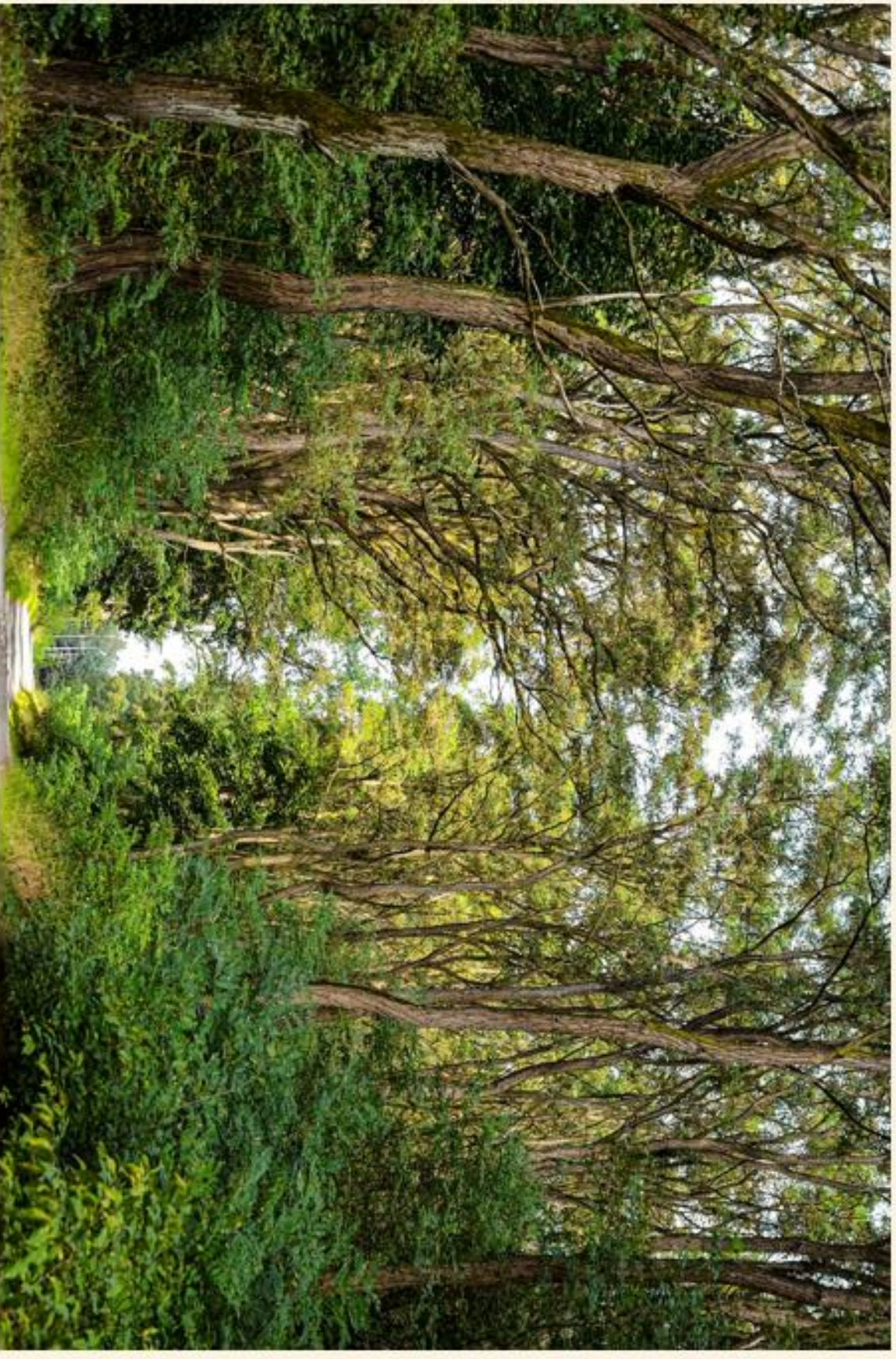
Servals and Colobus Monkeys live in the mountains.

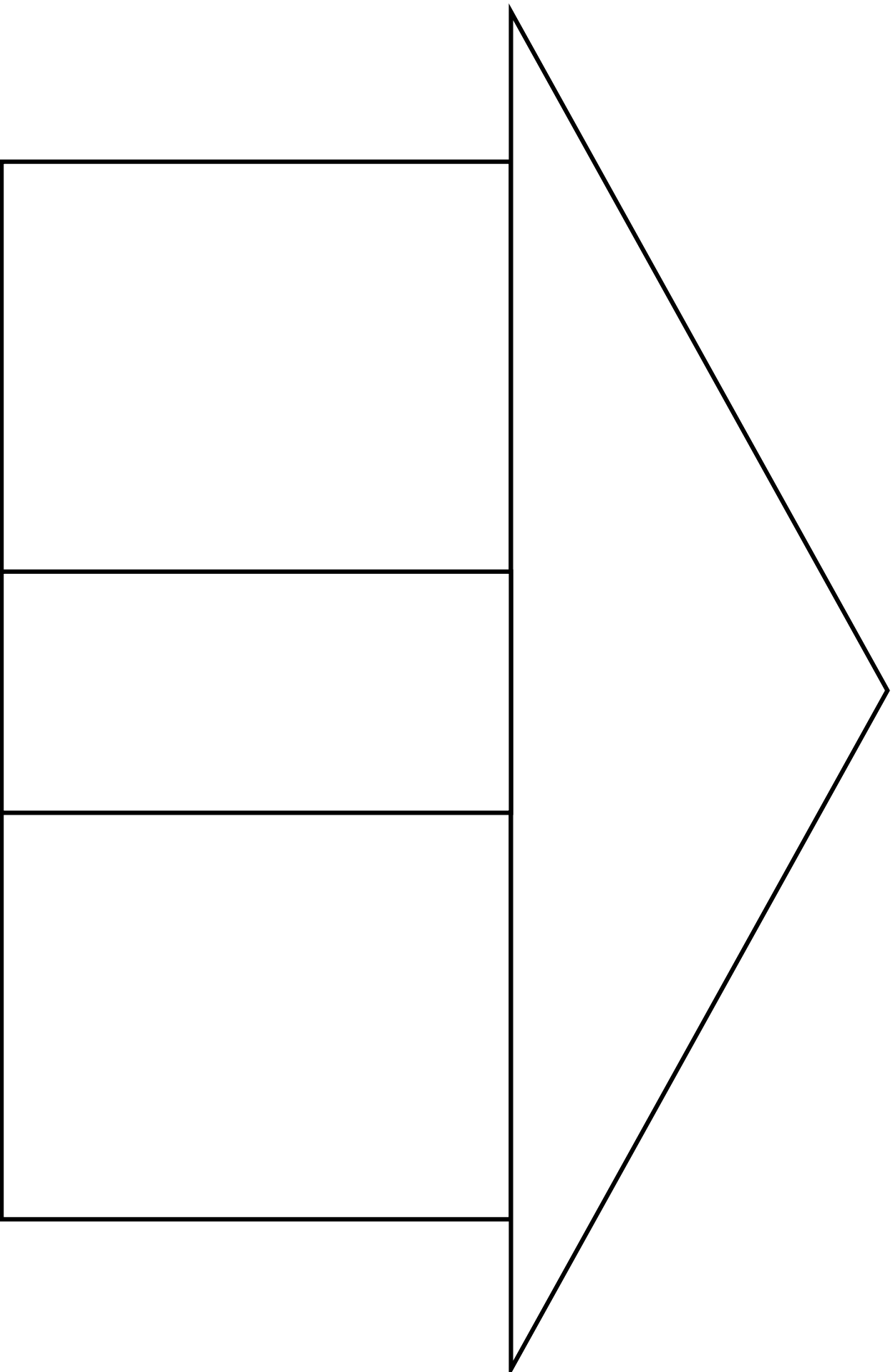
The longest river in the world is in Africa. It is called The Nile River. The Nile River flows over more than 4,000 miles through cities and deserts.
