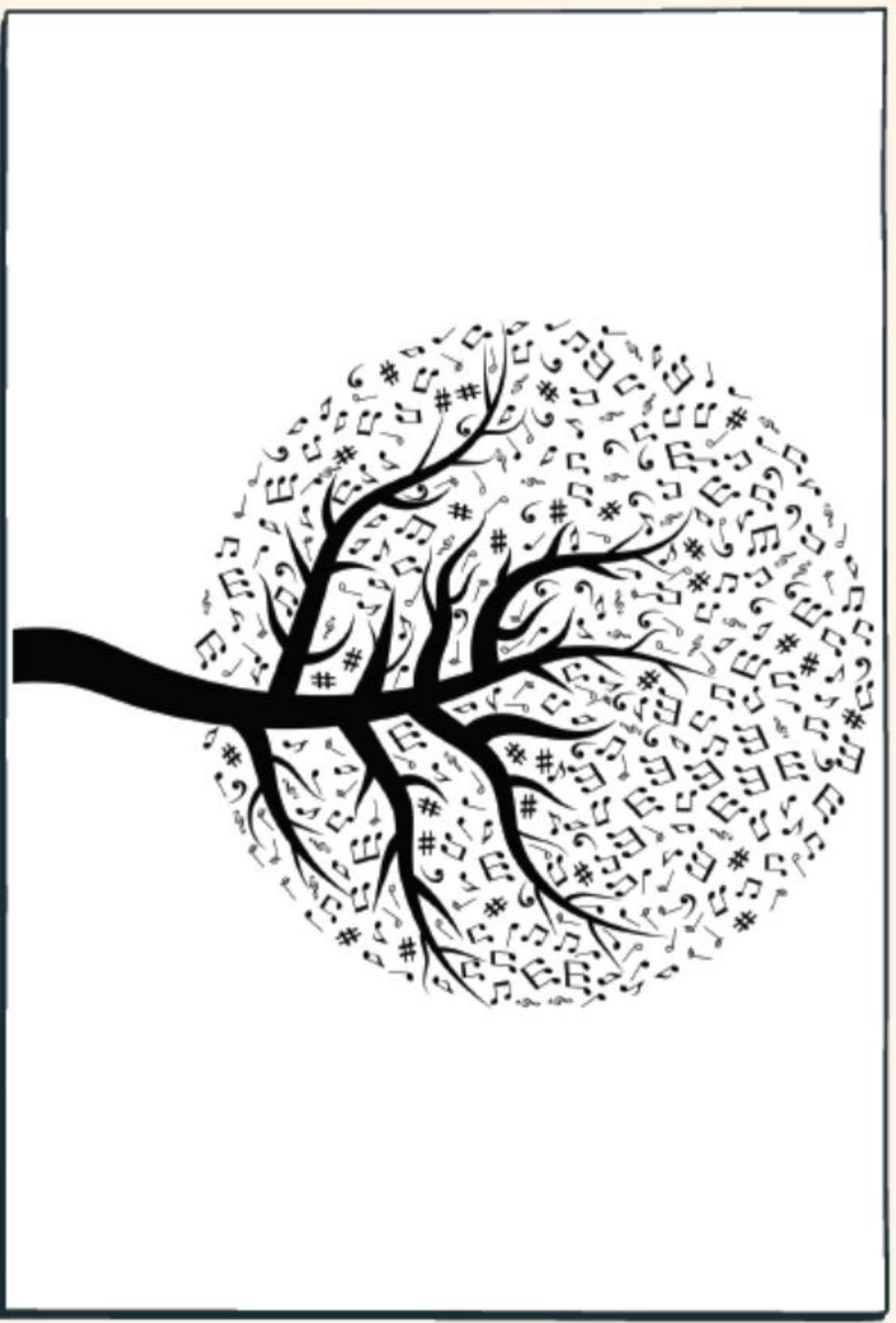

Music is made of **rhythms** and notes.



Rhythm is a steady beat like the boom of a drum, the slap of shoes on concrete, or the strike of a hammer on a nail. Listen as I clap a rhythm. My rhythm can be fast or it can be slow.

Notes are sounds that are high or low like the deep bark of a dog, the high call of a bird, or the jingle of bells. Listen as I sing a note. I can sing high and I can sing low.

Martha was the last passenger pigeon in the world. She lived at The Cincinnati Zoo and died in 1914. Passenger pigeons used to be the most numerous species of bird in the United States. Now, there are no more passenger pigeons. This mural reminds people of the importance of taking care of nature.

The Buzz Around Town

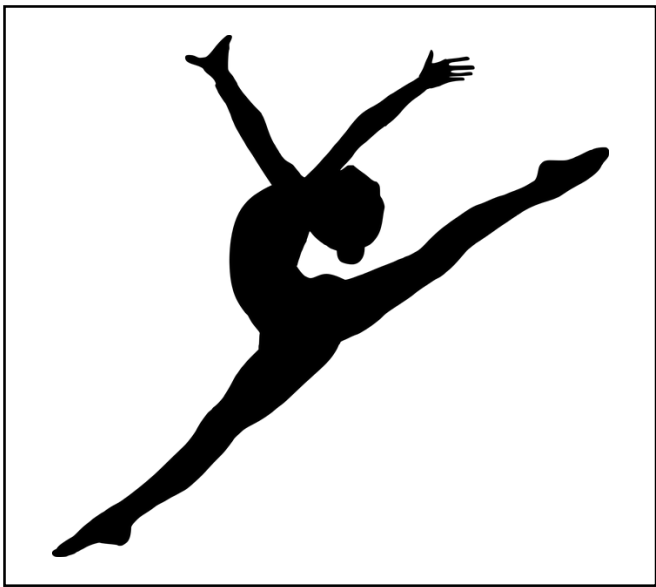
Artist: Paul Loehle

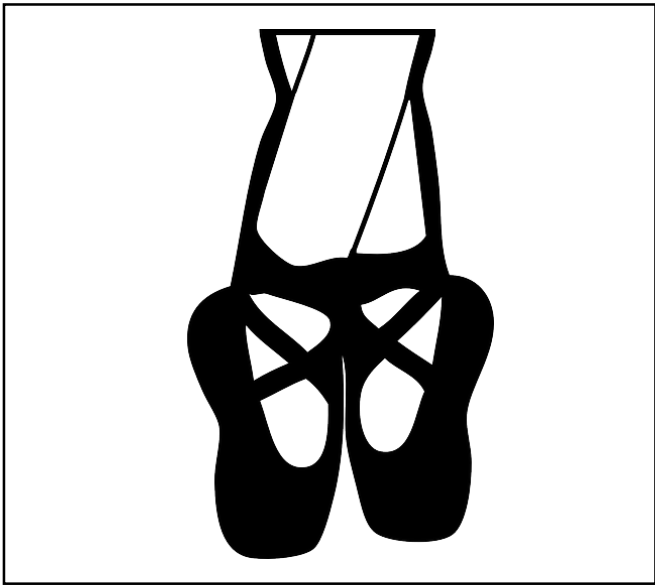
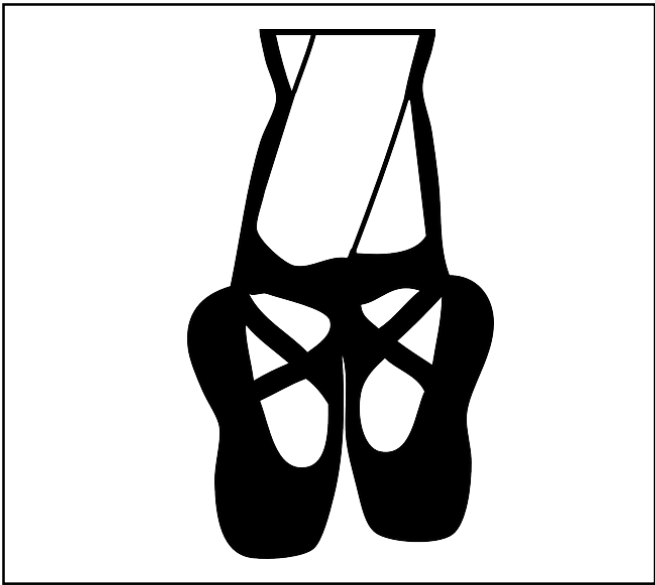
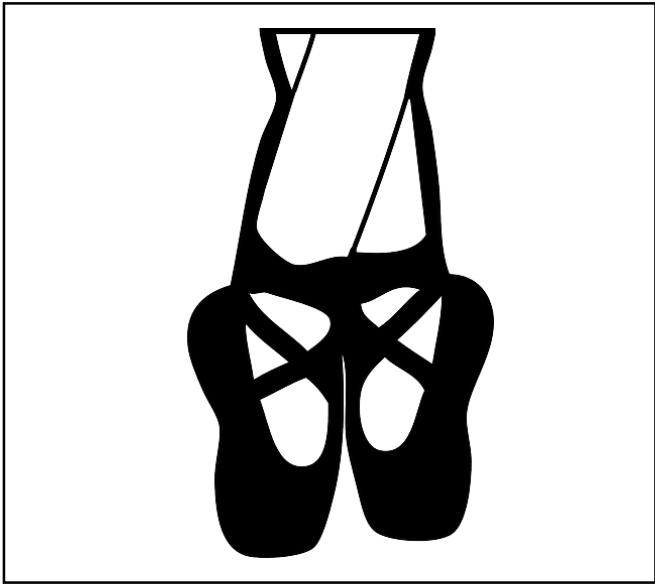
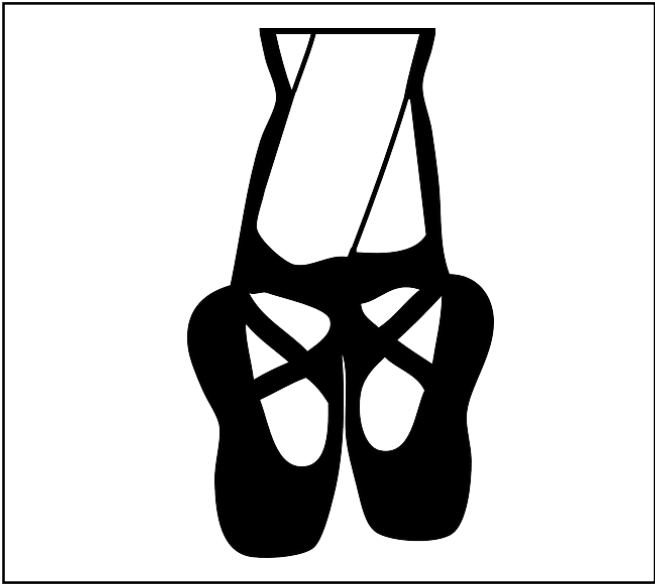
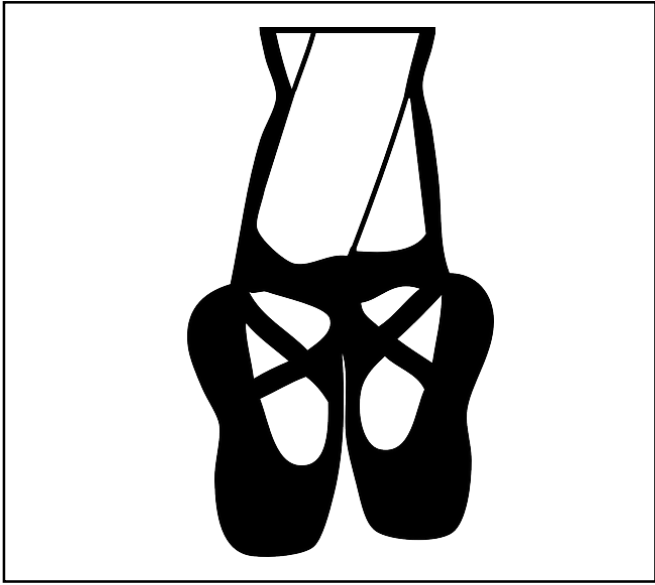
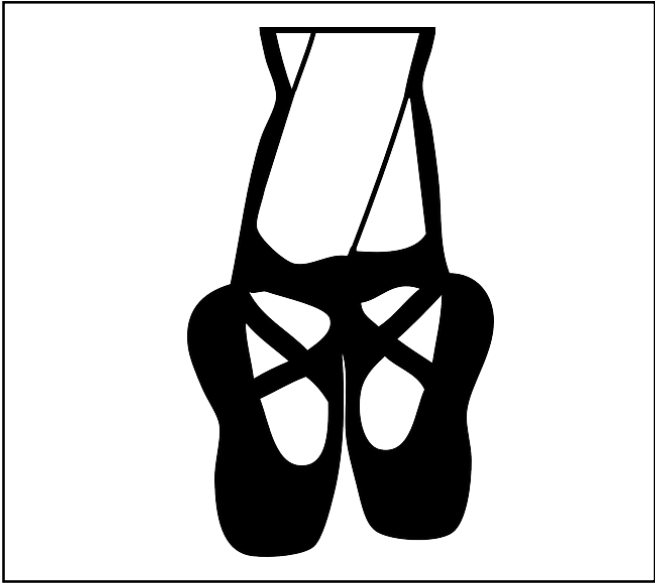
The mural is by Paul Loehle, a local artist and art educator. More than 11 artists worked together to create this mural.

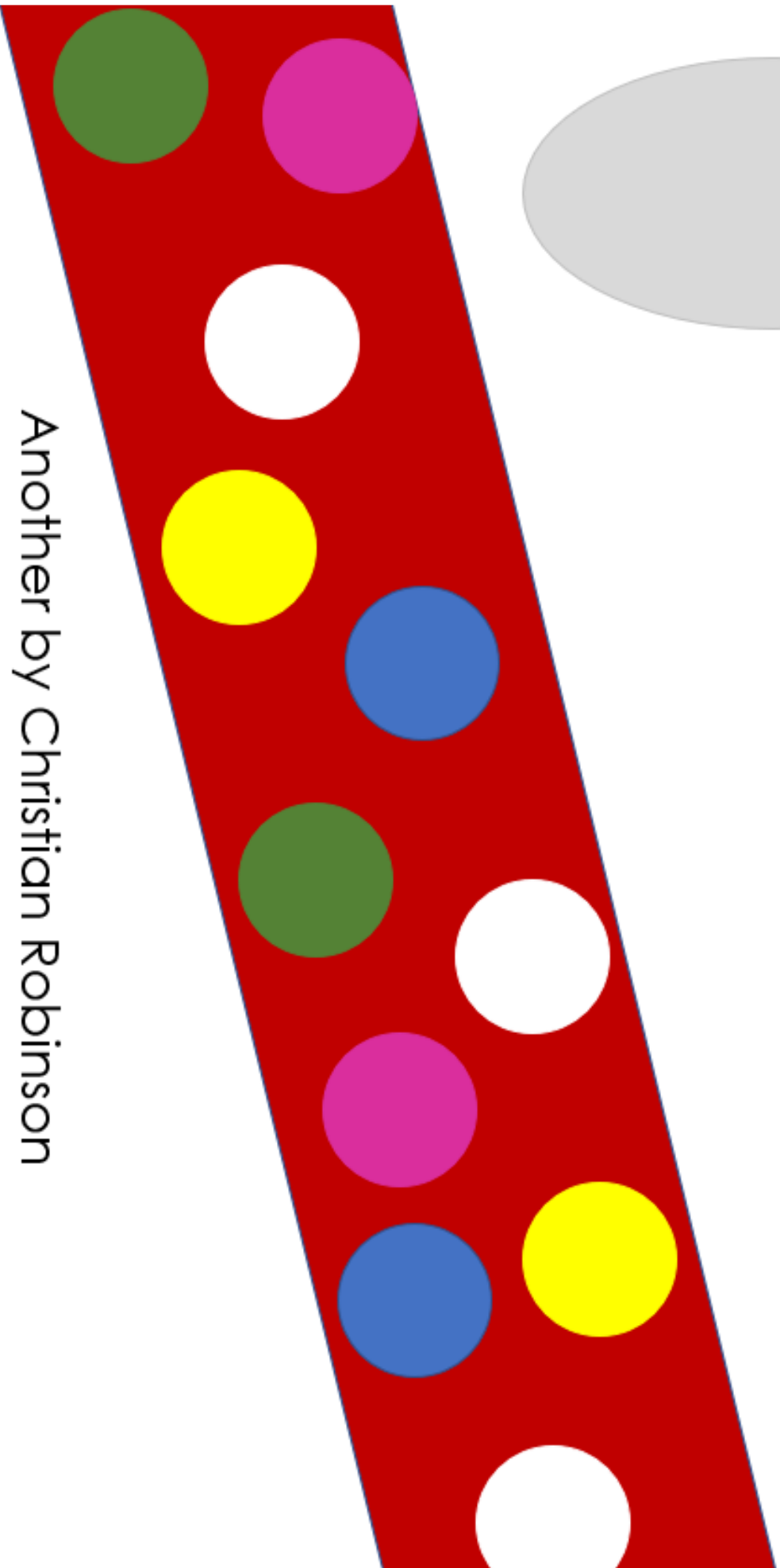
