
Successful Climbs

Mount Everest has been successfully climbed more than 10.000 times.



- The youngest person to climb Mount Everest was a thirteen year old from the United States of America named Jordan Romero.
- The oldest person to climb Mount Everest was Yuichiro Miura who was 80 years old.
- Kami Rita Sherpa from Nepal has climbed Mount Everest more than any other person. He has climbed the mountain more than 25







