Interesting Facts






Dingoes are related to dogs and wolves. They do not bark, but sometimes howl. Dingoes live in every habitat in Australia.

Many Australian animals are marsupials.


Marsupials are mammals with pouches for carrying their babies.




Very few Australians live in the middle of the country. 9 of every 10 Australians live on the edges, or coasts, of the country.


